REVELATION BOMB

I was speaking weeks ago about the release of top secret files as a distraction from what is happening with the economy and all of the mess that politics are. As you may or may not know, I have been skimming through these fallback narratives that are really surprising as they have confirmed some of the conspiracy theories I heard when I was in high school.

Fallback narrative stories are revealed or admitted, perhaps through the "accidental" release or leak of some documents or by that ever-useful narrative tool, the whistleblower. This fallback might even have some admissible semi-truths in it like good misinformation always does.

The aim will be as ever – to let some of the deception fall away, whilst protecting the core of the official narrative to provide fodder for frenzied but carefully curated debate. No matter how much they claim in congressional hearings that they are revealing stuff, they handle it in vague terms making us feel that what we find are various nothing burgers in these so-called declassified documents.

But that doesn't mean that they are not satisfactory, especially when It comes to conspiracy histories that have been put on the shelf, only to be true according to the new fall back narratives that when exposed are controversial.

I understand this is a big risk to take from the establishment point of view because once they start allowing that "official stories" can be a patchwork of lies, you invite other questions.

It would also mean playing an ace they've had up their sleeve for sometime, but I don't think you can ignore the signs.

The "big revelation" bomb is armed. It is being dropped and if no one is there to see it or hear it - it just does not have the impact that most revelation bombs do.

Back in the late 1980's when there was talk that the Soviet Union was going to disappear, one of the first things I remember was that The Pravda, the well known Soviet newspaper began revealing stories about Hitler surviving World War II and a strange story about an alien attack that killed an Army Battalion in the Soviet Union.

I remember being told that this was Soviet propaganda and not to believe what was being reported. There was always that saying "Trust But Verify " that was given by

Reagan with regard to anything that was coming out of the Soviet Union during the end of the Cold War.

I have always said the Cold War conspiracy theory is far more interesting than the stuff we talk about today. Maybe it is because I have a penchant for history but what is most surprising is when you remember hearing these outrageous conspiracies and then later in your life, declassified documents actually provide the information that you remember being dismissed as a false report.

Both of the conspiracy theories I have just cited have actually happened according to recently declassified documents.

In a year when we've already been told to brace ourselves for full disclosure on the assassinations of JFK, MLK, RFK, on America's UFO program and even the government's search for the Ark of the Covenant, perhaps this latest declassification effort should come as no surprise. Yet, it does.

Argentinian President Javier Milei announced that Argentina would be declassifying government archives related to Nazi activity in an effort to expose how war criminals escaped to the country following World War II.

The decision was made during a meeting with representatives from the Simon Wiesenthal Center who has championed the fight against antisemitism.

The move will grant researchers, along with the public, access to historical documents that may shed new light on the escape networks that helped Nazis evade arrest and resettle in South America.

According to The Jewish Chronicle, historians estimate that Argentina offered refuge to roughly 5,000 Nazi war criminals, including notorious Nazi figures, Adolf Eichmann and Josef Mengele.

The newly released archives could also provide deeper insight into the extent of local support that enabled arrival of the fleeing Nazis and their protection.

The declassified documents also has also revealed that Hitler allegedly did not commit suicide and continued to live in Bariloche Argentina after World war II.

According to Fox News:

"Argentina is set to declassify all government-held files relating to Nazi fugitives who fled and settled in Argentina after World War II, according to reports.

The documents will likely include Nazi-linked bank accounts and archival records detailing the use of Nazi "ratlines" which were monetary and logistic pathways Nazis used to escape justice and flee Argentina following the war."

Guillermo Alberto Francos, Argentina's interior minister, made the announcement Tuesday, the Buenos Aires Times reported citing DNEWS.

It is estimated that up to 10,000 Nazis and other Fascist war criminals escaped justice for Holocaust atrocities by fleeing to Argentina and other Latin American countries.

Notorious high-level Nazis, including Holocaust mastermind Adolph Eichmann and "Angel of Death" Josef Mengele, fled to the South American country, while rumors have swirled for years that former Nazi Party leader Adolf Hitler also ended up there. ...

Argentinian President Javier Milei ... promised officials of the Simon Wiesenthal Center his full cooperation in granting access to the documents. The center is famous for tracking down Nazis and is named after the famed Nazi hunter."

It seems as though Fox News is playing it safe by chalking Hitler's escape to Argentina as swirling "rumors." Which is their prerogative. But not everyone sees it as the stuff of mere rumors. And are anticipating nothing less than hard evidence that Hitler managed to do what he prevented tens of millions around the world from doing in the 1930s through 1945. Which was live peacefully to a ripe old age.

It has been reported that documents confirming Hitler's survival, escape to Argentina with US aid, living into the 1960's, and sired two daughters.

This mission was allegedly called "Operation Eagle Flight."

Rather than commit suicide on April 30th,1945 as the Soviet Red Army was closing in on his bunker, Hitler and Eva Braun were already gone. They'd used an escape tunnel to the subway, then to a plane that was standing by for them. All arranged by Martin Bormann.

The flight took them to Denmark. Then to the Baltics. Then to Spain, where the government was paid off with Nazi gold. Then the Canary Islands, where they got on board Nazi submarine – a U-518, which was designed with battery life enough to cross the Atlantic round trip on a single charge.

U-518 was supposedly sunk by the Allies, but no sign of its destruction was ever recovered or even spotted. Later a Police Commissioner in Argentina reported it was spotted along the coast, but he was ordered to disregard the eyewitness accounts. Then in 2022, researchers found an identical make and model U-Boat sunk in the very spot witnesses said they saw subs being scuttled, dove the site and positively identified it as U-518. But was told that was just a rock formation.

Bormann's plan had included a phase code named "Operation Land of Fire" which consisted of a "secret paradise" German village in Patagonia. The Argentine President

then was Juan Peron, the husband of Evita. The Perons were all too happy to assist the Nazis, before he himself was overthrown.

Much of this was always talked about in Argentine tabloids -- the legends and rumors did not go away and has been selling newspapers for decades.

Not long after Germany's surrender, the OSS (the Department of War's precursor to the CIA) decoded a message from Bormann to Argentina: "The package arrives." Now, that's not definitive proof he was talking about Hitler. But given all the time, effort, and investment that went into building the infrastructure of the place, it's not out of the realm of possibility.

Next, there are plenty of eyewitness accounts of people who not only saw, but met and spoke with an aging Fuhrer. A maid. A hotel owner. A gardener. A farmer. A shopkeeper. They could've all been wrong about meeting the single most recognizable person of the 20th century. But do the math.

Now in the recent declassification of the JFK documents, we learn more about the situation

JFK assassination documents include a 1955 CIA document where an asset reports a former SS Officer telling him Hitler was still alive. And the file includes a photo of Hitler alive and well.

Among those convinced that Hitler not only escaped, but did so with help from the US was Stalin. Though the Russians did claim to have parts of his skull. A few years ago, that bone fragment was tested and turned out to have the DNA of a woman in her 40s. They still claim to have his jaw, but after the embarrassment of that big reveal, the testing is pretty much over.

Furthermore, there is another declassified document from these recent revelations about the other story that was front page in the Pravda in 1989.

The bone-chilling document declassified by the CIA has exposed an alleged massacre by aliens from a crashed UFO who turned an entire military unit into stone.

According to the report, Soviet troops shot down a flying saucer hovering over the Soviet military unit in Siberia and what happened next was truly terrifying.

In the document, summarizing a 250-page top secret file acquired by US intelligence agents, eyewitnesses said five aliens climbed out of their wrecked craft, combined themselves into one creature, exploded in a burst of intense energy, and turned 23 soldiers into solid rock.

One CIA official referred to the shocking battle as 'a horrific picture of revenge on the part of extraterrestrial creatures, a picture that makes one's blood freeze.'

The agency added that the 'extremely menacing case' proved the aliens who visited Earth possessed weapons and technology far beyond the US government's 'assumptions' suggesting they were already aware of the aliens' existence.

The 23 'petrified soldiers' could not be saved. Their remains and the debris from the spacecraft were reportedly moved to a secret research base near Moscow.

An even more concerning detail of the CIA file is the description of the aliens reportedly involved in this massacre, who have been mentioned in UFO reports and sightings for nearly 80 years.

The subject of the document states: 'Paper reports alleged evidence on mishap involving UFO.'

This extraordinary tale was also published in the Ukrainian newspaper Holos Ukrayiny on March 27, 1993.

The incident, which a Canadian newspaper believed took place between 1989 and 1990, was only uncovered by the CIA after the fall of the Soviet Union and its 'secret police' organization, the KGB.

The CIA document explained that the alleged alien craft was flying low and quietly above the Soviet union while they were engaged in a training mission.

Officials wrote that 'for unknown reasons' the Soviets launched a surface-to-air missile at the UFO, sending it crashing to the Earth near the unit's position.

According to the only two soldiers who survived, when the soldiers approached the craft, the five aliens freed themselves of the debris and came close together near the wreck.

Moments later, the soldiers said the group of aliens 'merged into a single object that acquired a spherical shape.' In simpler language, the aliens beings somehow morphed into a giant ball.

That's when the new ball-like alien entity began to buzz and hiss before igniting into a brilliant white light.

With the soldiers still looking on, the ball of light erupted like a giant flare of energy, turning 23 of the 25 Soviets into 'stone poles.'

The report stated that the only reason two of the men survived was because they were standing in a shaded area at the time of the alien energy blast.

Testing of the soldier's bodies showed the alien flare had somehow changed living tissue into a substance that closely resembles limestone.

Even in 2025, the science behind such a shocking transformation is still difficult to explain medically and technologically.

According to the Journal of Applied Physics, it is possible to use high-energy radiation or electromagnetic pulses to change normal matter into plasma - a form that's not a liquid, solid, or gas. In the report, the CIA described the aliens as short humanoids with 'large heads and large black eyes.'

The account matches who UFO researchers, alleged alien abductees, and others who believe in alien life refer to as a race called 'the Greys.'

Despite their prominent place in extraterrestrial research, this disturbing incident appears to be the first time humans have alleged that these beings could have accomplished such terrifying feats.

We have always been told that aliens have never harmed anyone -- but in this case it sounds like a revenge attack.

The most unappealing outcomes would arise if extraterrestrials caused harm to humanity, even if by accident. While aliens may arrive to eat, enslave or attack us, the report adds that people might also suffer from being physically crushed or by contracting diseases carried by the visitors. In especially unfortunate incidents, humanity could be wiped out when a more advanced civilization accidentally unleashes an unfriendly artificial intelligence, or performs a catastrophic physics experiment that renders a portion of the galaxy uninhabitable.

I know that it is extreme but so is the idea that aliens are in anyway saviors for us to wait for.

Life does not seem to include a Deus Ex Machina but who knows?

Extraterrestrials may be wary of civilizations that expand very rapidly, as these may be prone to destroy other life as they grow, just as humans have pushed species to extinction on Earth. In the most extreme scenario, aliens might choose to destroy humanity to protect other civilizations.

It is obvious or at least it is being declassified that our contact with extraterrestrials, need us to seriously consider the potential scenarios that may help to plot the future path of human civilization, avoid collapse and achieve long-term survival.
